NFAI and National Institute of Naturopathy signs MoU for study in Gandhian Studies

Aimed at furthering the research related to Gandhian Studies, National Film Archive of India (NFAI) and National Institute of Naturopathy (NIN), Pune (Ministry of Ayush) have signed a Memorandum of Understanding MoU. The MoU was signed by Dr K Satyalakshmi, Director NIN and Prakash Magdum, Director NFAI in the presence of Santish Ajmera, OSD and Keerti Tiwari, Deputy Director NFAI.
